

EXTENDED DAY.....
EXTENDED PLAY!!!

Have you heard about our wonderful Extended Day program? You may choose to extend your child's morning class time until 2:00 pm. This can be done on a regular or occasional basis.

What happens when you leave your child for an extended day? Extended Day is an extension of the morning preschool experience with a little more emphasis on independence and positive guidance on making choices. The afternoon schedule consists of:

12:30 We'll gather the group from lunch time.

12:30 - 2:00 Time will be divided between outside play time; tricycles, sand play, climbing structures or just swinging to "touch the sky". There will also be classroom time. We'll play with puzzles, dress up, play dough, block building or reading corner etc., - your child has a chance to make the choice.

Extended Day provides a variety of advantages:

For the Pre-K child: This is a chance to prepare them for next year's all-day kindergarten, while giving them time to do those "extras" that time ran out for in the morning!

For the 3 year old: There is time to play with the things they most enjoyed in the morning, but had limited time. For those children who have older siblings attending all-day school, this is a place filled with friends in the afternoon.

For the parents: Time for yourself, for those afternoon appointments or projects that can't be done with little "helpers" along. This time is especially useful for holiday shopping, or if you are not feeling well.
