**WE WELCOME BISHOP BEVERLY SHAMANA** this morning as our preacher for today's United Methodist Women Sunday. Bishop Beverly Shamana was elected to the episcopacy in 2000 and assigned to the California-Nevada in the San Francisco Area until 2008 when she retired and returned to Los Angeles with her husband, Walter Woods. While serving as an active bishop, she was President of the General Board of Church and Society and traveled on behalf of the Board for issues of peace and justice. She is a graduate of Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary and served as pastor in Los Angeles and Inglewood, and as Conference Staff for Ethnic, Justice & Outreach Ministries until her election by the Western Jurisdiction. She continues to preach, and lead workshops and seminars on art and creativity, which inspired her book, *Seeing In The Dark, A Vision of Spirituality and Creativity* published by Abingdon Press.
