Pandemic Emergency Procedures

Pandemic

1. (of a disease) prevalent over a whole country or world
2. An outbreak of a pandemic disease

The Preschool will implement the Pandemic Emergency Response under the guidance and direction of the CDC, federal and local governments, and the Department of Health.

Decisions made by the Preschool and the SDUMC Pandemic Team will consider the safety of children, families, and staff. Decisions may include:

- Closure of the Preschool
Length of closure to be determined by Preschool, CDC, federal and local governments.
- Adjusted hours of service
- Daily health checks of children and staff (fever of 100 and above must go home)
Exclude child with: fever (need 72hrs fever free to return)
Cough or shortness of breath
Other signs of illness, such as flush checks, rapid breathing or difficulty breathing (without recent physical activity) fatigue, or extreme fussiness.
- Limited entry into the building
- Limited access to the property
- Limitations on what the children may bring into the Preschool, such as
Blankets, Stuffed Animals, Pillows, and Toys.

All families and staff will notify the Preschool immediately if they test positive with COVID-19 or have reason to believe they have been exposed to COVID-19.

The Preschool will communicate these plans through mass emails.
