He touches me with eternal joy.

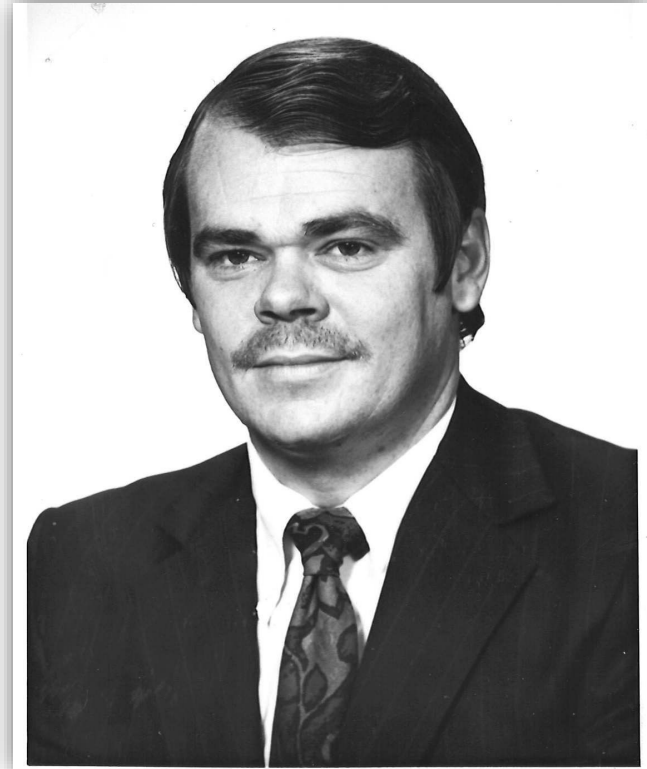
When I feel empty and alone.
